## Here are some questions you can think and talk about!

Imagine you are living in the year 1917, and America has entered the war. What are some ways you might support the war effort at home? For example, you could get a group of friends together and ask for donations for Liberty Bonds. What are some other ideas?

Look at the propaganda posters in the "Historic Photos & Images" page. What are some things you notice about them? Who do you think the audience is for the posters? What emotions do you think the posters are trying to make people feel?

In the book *Knit Your Bit*, Mikey wants to do something BIG to help the soldiers. But he learns that if a lot of people make a little effort, it creates something even bigger than one person can do alone. Think about an issue in your community today - for example, the environment, helping those in need, etc. What are some small things you can do to help make a difference? (Some ideas to get you started: spend some time picking up trash in a local park, donate non-perishables to a food pantry, donate supplies to an animal shelter, etc.)
